#### **Communication and Language**

We will... Use new vocabulary in context with pictures to discuss and prompt. Retell traditional stories and key texts. Sing traditional songs and rhymes. Share key events with others – what do you celebrate and how? Have circle time sharing images and artefacts from different religions and festivals.

# Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will...Think about the perspectives of others – listen to and discuss with other children. Begin to have an understanding that people have differing traditions and beliefs.

# Literacy

We will... Use topic based vocabulary. Read non-fiction texts about different religions and holidays. Draw pictures of different traditions and celebrations. Clap the syllables of different religious artefacts.

## Maths

We will... Explore calendars, days and months of the year. Explore size and weight of gifts/bags. Create patterns on wrapping paper.

# **Understanding the World**

We will...Invite visitors to talk about religion and traditions. Look at artefacts and objects. Visit a place of worship. Include different items and costumes in the role play area. Explore non-fiction texts about the different traditions.

## **Expressive Arts and Design**

We will... Design and create cards for different occasions. Act out stories. Use different tools and resources to create decorations to celebrate different traditions. Sing and dance to different music from different traditions.

## **Physical Development**

We will... Explore Wrapping 'gifts'. Decorate the environment. Use tools to create our own decorations. Dance to different traditional music.






Y1 and Y2: Miss Pope Y3 and Y4: Mrs Wright
