This term we are thinking about "Who am I?" and "Who am I becoming?"

We are thinking about how we can understand our identity—the things we are good at and the things we want to get better at. We will also be thinking about how we can celebrate what other people are good at and how we are different.

Then we will think about how we are going to achieve our goals for this year and who we want to be.

Communication, Language and Literacy, Reading and Writing

- We will be using the Book Wings Phonics scheme to teach Phonics this year. This will incorporate well known stories and a range of exciting games to teach children letters, sounds and tricky words. We can't wait!
- We will be engaging in 'Busy Fingers' on arrival to develop our fine motor skills and pencil grip. We will also be practising recognising and writing our names this term.

Mathematical Development

- We will practise counting forwards and backwards to 10 this term.
- We will practise recognising up to 5 objects without needing to count them.
- We will build using 2D shapes and talk about shapes and their properties whilst building.

Expressive Arts and Design

- We will be engaging in imaginative role play in our indoor role play house and our outdoor builders yard.
- We will be singing a range of different songs and using instruments to create different effects.

Understanding of the World

- We will talk about our families and people who are important to us.
- We will explore different types of buildings in the local area and talk about our own homes.
- We will look at maps of Lawrence Weston and identify different building.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- This term we will be building relationships with adults and other children within our class.
- We will be talking about our feelings and each morning we will put our name into a feelings bucket.
