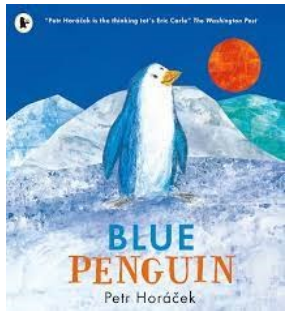

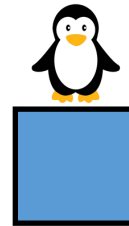
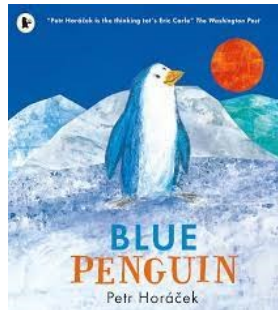

Mathematical Development
