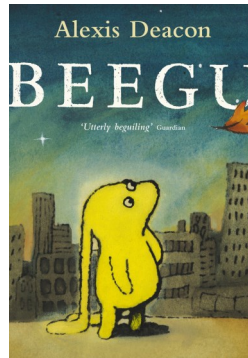


# Year 1 Newsletter Term 1
