Books we are reading:

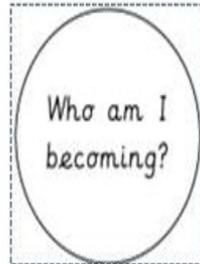
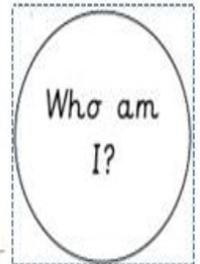
We will be reading leaf and using this book to support are writing by exploring the story and the pictures.
