There will be a weekly challenge set on Sumdog for children to practise their maths skills.

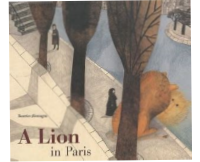
Please ensure reading diaries are brought into school daily especially on a Friday. This year, we will be continuing to use Spelling shed to practice spellings at home.

Following on from Term 1, we will be encouraging the children to think about how we can work for a better tomorrow and how we can be positive people who help others to be the same.



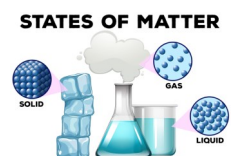
**Topic:** I wonder what impacts natural disasters have on the world?

**Geography:** Children will explore volcanoes and earthquakes in geography this term. This exciting topic allows the children to discover specific features of volcanoes and earthquakes and how they occur.
