This term we are thinking about "Who am I?" and "Who am I becoming?"

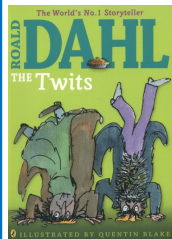
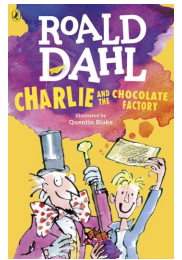
We are thinking about how we can understand our identity—the things we are good and the things we want to get better at. We will also be thinking about how we can celebrate what other people are good at and how we are different.

This term we are reading 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' by Roald Dahl.



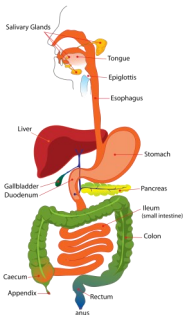
We will also read 'The Twits' as part of our read aloud time in class.
