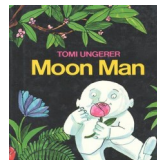
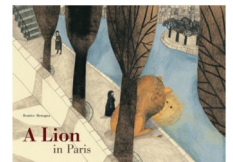
The habits for November and December are Hopeful and Joyful.

This term we are reading 'Lion in Paris' by Beatrice Alemagna and 'Moon Man' by Tomi Ungerer.

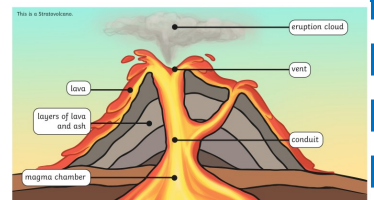


We will also read 'Charlotte's Web' as part of our read aloud time in class.

This term's topic for the whole school is Citizenship and the World and Year 4 are focussing on Extreme Earth, and the Ancient Greeks.

In Term 2, all of our learning will be based on the question: I wonder what makes our Earth extreme?

History: In history, we will be learning about the Ancient Greeks and how their culture still influences our lives today.



Geography: In geography, we will be learning about how extreme our Earth can be! We will focus on volcanoes, earthquakes and learn about the water cycle.
