In the first week of term, across the school we will be reading 'What we'll build' by Oliver Jeffers.

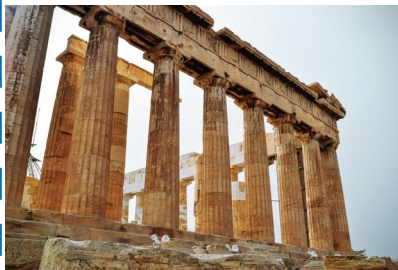


This term we are reading 'Leon and the Place Between' by Angela McAllister.



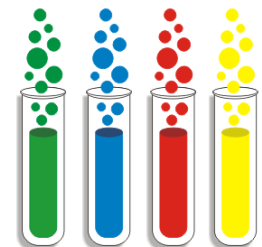
We are also reading 'Helping Hercules' by Francesca Simon.

Topic: This term our topic is I wonder what the Ancient Greeks have done for me?



History: In history, we will be looking at the lives of the Ancient Greeks and their achievements. We will look at their system of democracy, the start of the Olympics and some of their famous battles such as The Trojan War. We will study their Greek Gods and Goddesses and we will be able to locate where Greece is on the map—knowing that it is in Europe. We will look at what parts of their society still exist in ours today.

Science: In our science lesson, we will be exploring a variety of everyday materials and think about what these materials can be used for. We will also look at the difference between solids, liquids and gasses and thinking about evaporation.
