These are some of the things we will be covering:

Geography- In our geography lessons we will be learning about the Amazon Basin, Climate Zones, biomes, rivers, mountains, volcanoes, earthquakes & water cycle in relation to its wildlife and natural habitats. We will also be identifying areas of rainforest (including countries) on a World Map, identifying the Equator and Tropics of Capricorn and Cancer, Asia, Africa and South America. We will also learn about deforestation and how it has a negative effect on our environment
