This term we are reading ‘There’s a boy in the girls’ bathroom’ by Louis Sachar.

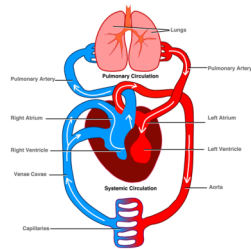


We will use this to direct our writing and will read it aloud during the school day.

## In Term 1, all of our learning will be based on the question: Who am I and who am I becoming?

**History:** In history, we will be learning to understand how people’s lived experience of the past influenced future choices and impacts people today. We will also be thinking about our place in time. We will be answering the question “I wonder how migration has affected Britain?”

**Geography:** In geography, we will be learning about geographical regions and topographical features of the world. We will also learn about what a biome is and identify and locate where they are in the world.



**Science:** In our science lessons, we will be learning about the circulatory system. We will learn how our lungs and heart work and how we can help to keep them healthy.
