<p>Reading:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - An extract from 'My Friend Walter' by Michael Morpurgo. - Read the extract, looking for the clues that are highlighted and then complete the quiz. <p><i>This should take around 30-45 minutes.</i></p> <p>Writing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Week 2 of an adventure story about stealing the Crown Jewels from the Tower of London. - A PowerPoint of how to structure the paragraph and what to include. <p><i>Planning and writing should take about an hour.</i></p> <p>Grammar:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Watch the video clip about what synonyms and antonyms are – words that are either similar or opposite. - Then complete the quiz to say whether the words are synonyms or antonyms. <p><i>This activity should take you around 30 minutes.</i></p>	<p>Week 2, dividing fractions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A PowerPoint explaining the different parts of a fraction and the steps for dividing fractions together with a question to try and check your answer to. Also, a reminder of the different methods of multiplication. - A quiz with 12 marks using a combination of multiplying through rolling numbers and a short and long method of multiplication. <p><i>This should take around 30-45 minutes but I can provide more questions to check understanding if it is needed.</i></p>	<p>Learning about The Tudors</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Activity 1 – familiarise yourself with the Kings and Queens of Tudor Britain using the poster. Then answer the questions in the quiz about these facts. <i>This should take between 20 minutes and half an hour.</i> - Activity 2 – Design your own or your family's own shield with pictures and words that represent what you think is important. <i>This could take anywhere from 20 minutes to an hour.</i> 	
<p>Art activities</p> <p>African Animal Challenge</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Create a picture, painting or drawing of one of the animals that lives in Africa and write some facts about that animal. - Task sheets that can be used are attached to the assignment but you can choose any animal you wish. - Use the website link to Noah's Ark Zoo Farm to find the information you need about the animals. <p><i>This activity could take anywhere from 30 minutes to a couple of hours. You could even do one animal each day if you wanted to.</i></p>	<p>PE activities</p> <p>5 Just Dance Songs</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Could be done as one each day of the week or all in one go. - Songs last between 3 and 5 minutes. - Each one will have a question that goes with it in the quiz so keep your eyes peeled! <p><i>There are plenty online so do go exploring for more if you enjoy the activity.</i></p>	<p>4 Habits activities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - An orange expedition – in your daily exercise (or around your house), see what orange items you can find. Take a picture or draw what you find and send it in! <i>This could take up to an hour depending on how long you can exercise for.</i> - Have a look at the April habit activities such as making your own volcano at home, painting kindness pebbles or seeing what random acts of kindness you can do. <i>Each activity can take anywhere from 15 minutes to an hour.</i>
