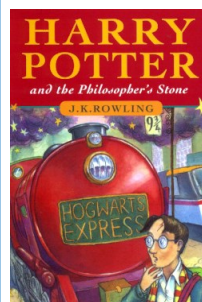
Important class dates:

Habits: The habits for March and April are Forgiving and Considerate.

We will be looking for children who are able to forgive others by choosing to not let past actions affect future actions.

We will also be looking for children who choose to care about others and treat them in the way that they wish to be treated.



What we are reading this term: This term we will be reading Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone. Harry Potter is a boy who learns on his eleventh birthday that he is the orphaned son of two powerful wizards and possesses unique magical powers of his own. He is summoned from his life as an unwanted child to become a student at Hogwarts, an English boarding school for wizards. There, he meets several friends who become his closest allies and help him discover the truth about his parents' mysterious deaths.
