

This term we are thinking about 'Who am I?' We are thinking about how we can understand our identity. The things we are good at and the things we want to get better at. We will also be thinking about how we can celebrate what other people are good at and how we are different.

Books we are reading:

For the first week of term we are reading 'Here we are' by Oliver Jeffers. For the rest of the term, we will be reading 'The Gruffalo' by Julia Donaldson and 'I want my hat back' by Jon Klassen. These 3 books are lovely and I know the children will enjoy them as much as I do.



Topic: This term our topic is "What do I know about me?".

Trips and visitors: This is currently to be confirmed.

Science: In science we are looking at animals including humans. We will be looking at a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. Also we will be learning about the basic parts of a body and which part of the body is associated with each sense.

Geography: In geography we are focusing on field work outside of the classroom, we will be learning what a map is and what it is used for. We will also be learning about key physical features such as cliffs, beaches, the coast, seasons and weather. In History we will be studying significant historical events, people and places in our local area.
