

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children should have a good understanding of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom. Understand and identify the seven continents and 5 oceans. Children will be able to understand simple map symbols and why they are used instead of just drawing objects of places. Children will understand that we live in England and how Wales, Scotland and Ireland are classed as a different countries. Children will learn about the Wright brothers and the first aircraft.

Skills	Teaching Strategies
Explore	Explore and locate the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom. Split lesson over two days. Discuss the difference between England, Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales. Discuss with the class if the other countries speak a different language? Talk partners before learning more. Using Paddington bear for the whole topic. Paddington will be going to all the places we will be looking at in our topic.
Observe	Observe the first aircraft and learn about the Wright brothers. Paddington will be going back in time to show the class the first aircraft and new information about the Wright brothers. Who were they? What are they famous for? Class discussion before the learning.
Explore	Explore simple improvements in aircraft history. Paddington will be looking at the first aircraft to be built and ask the children what do they see? He will then show them an aircraft now and show the difference between the two. Class discussion based on similarities and differences.
Identify	Children to identify the seven continents and five oceans in the world. Show the children Paddington bear on an adventure around the world. Follow Paddington's journey across the seven continents and five oceans from the United Kingdom.
Identify	Identify the impact from improvements in modern travel.. Paddington will be looking at the different ways we can travel now. What improvements have been made over the years? Class discussion about health and safety, time it takes to travel etc.
Explore	Explore map symbols and why they are used. Show the children a map of Teddy's travels in England. Use the map to show where he went and why he was there. Show the children different symbols and can they guess what they mean.
Observe	Observe the history of Concorde developed in Filton. Paddington will show the children a short video of Concorde's first and last flight. Have children discuss the videos, what's the same?
