FSM VOUCERS FOR SUMMER HOLIDAY

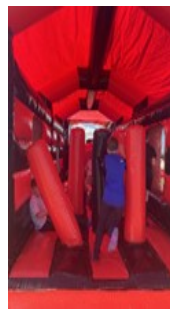
