### FARESHARE FOOD/ FOOD PANTRY



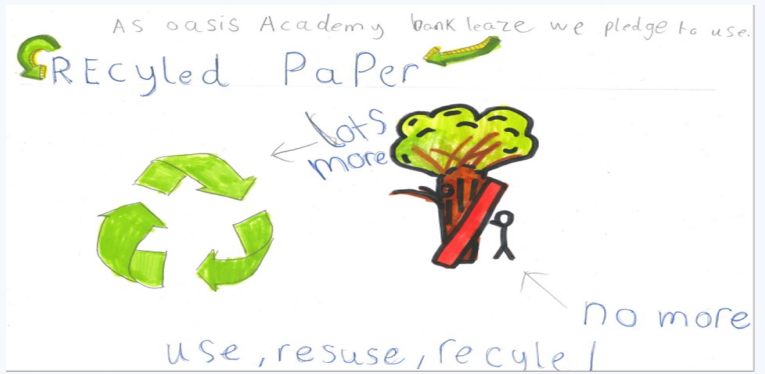
