## WHEELS ON THE PATHWAY

## ARE YOU ENTITLED TO FREE SCHOOL MEALS?

### Free School Meals

The criteria for this and changes in who can receive free school meals is complicated! However, it is always worth checking if you are eligible for FSM. Any successful claims made before March 2023 will allow you child with protected FSM for potentially the next 6 years- so it is worth checking! Speak to Affonso in the office if your circumstances have changed or you are not sure if your child is eligible- he can help you check. After March 2023 the criteria is changing with the benefit being annually accessed on income for all who have claimed after March 2023. Currently Rec, Y1 and Y2 all get free school meals under a scheme called 'Universal' Free School meals- this is separate to the income assessed benefit of Free School Meals.

This week we are looking at the habit 'Compassionate.' We will be focusing on the following behaviour indicators:



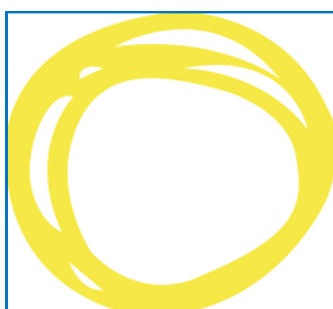
- Children who notice those who need help and does what they can to make their situation better.
