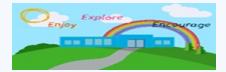

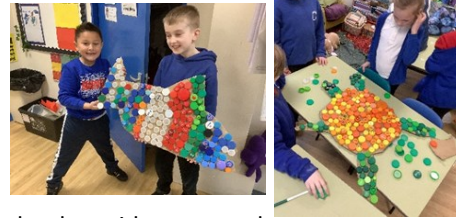
## PUPIL'S ONSITE BEFORE SCHOOL

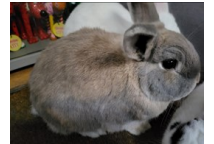
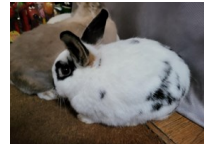

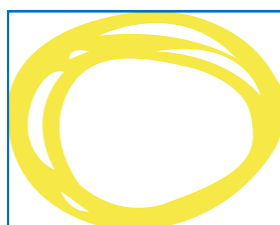


## ABSENCE
