### FARESHARE FOOD/ FOOD PANTRY

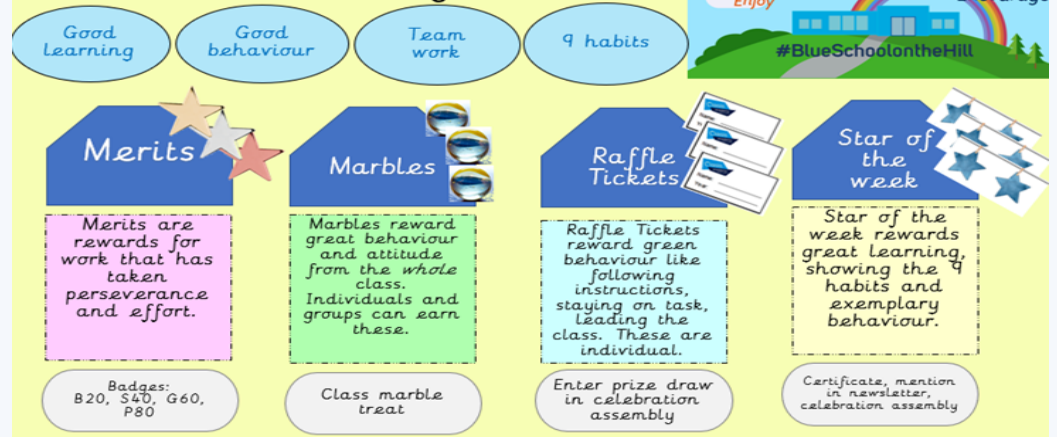


We are now calling our FARESHARE food delivery-Food Pantry. Food from fareshare will be available to be collected from 2:45pm every Thursday from the Hub Room.

## BEHAVIOUR AT BANK LEAZE

"Pupils are a credit to the school. They respect staff and have a good sense of right and wrong. Pupils are polite and behave well."

We are so proud of our pupils here at Bank Leaze and the way that they behave and completely echo the words that Ofsted wrote about them in December. We are continually working alongside the children to support them in their decision making and teach them how to become well-behaved members of our school and their society.

Did you know there are many ways that we reward good behaviour at Bank Leaze? We have shared this graphic recently with the children to remind them of what rewards they can get for good learning, behaviour and teamwork.

We also have consequences to our actions at Bank Leaze. For example, if a child gets 5 yellows in a week, they will have to go on a Green Chart to support them to make good decisions and track their behaviour. And if a child gets 2 reds in a week, they will either have a phone call home from a principal if they are in KS1 or a warning letter of a detention if they are in KS2. We haven't had to use these consequences yet with any of our pupils but it is important to know that if your child's teacher is sharing about yellows and reds with you, this could be the next step for them.

Thank you for all you do to support us with your child/ren and their behaviour. We greatly appreciate this and are very proud of all of our pupils. Here's to a great year! Miss Parsons

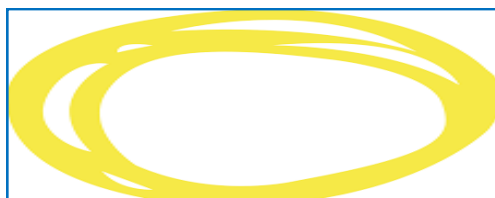


## WHO AM I BECOMING? October
