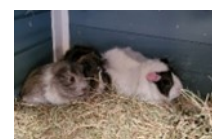
YEAR 3 OBSERVE THE LOCAL AREA

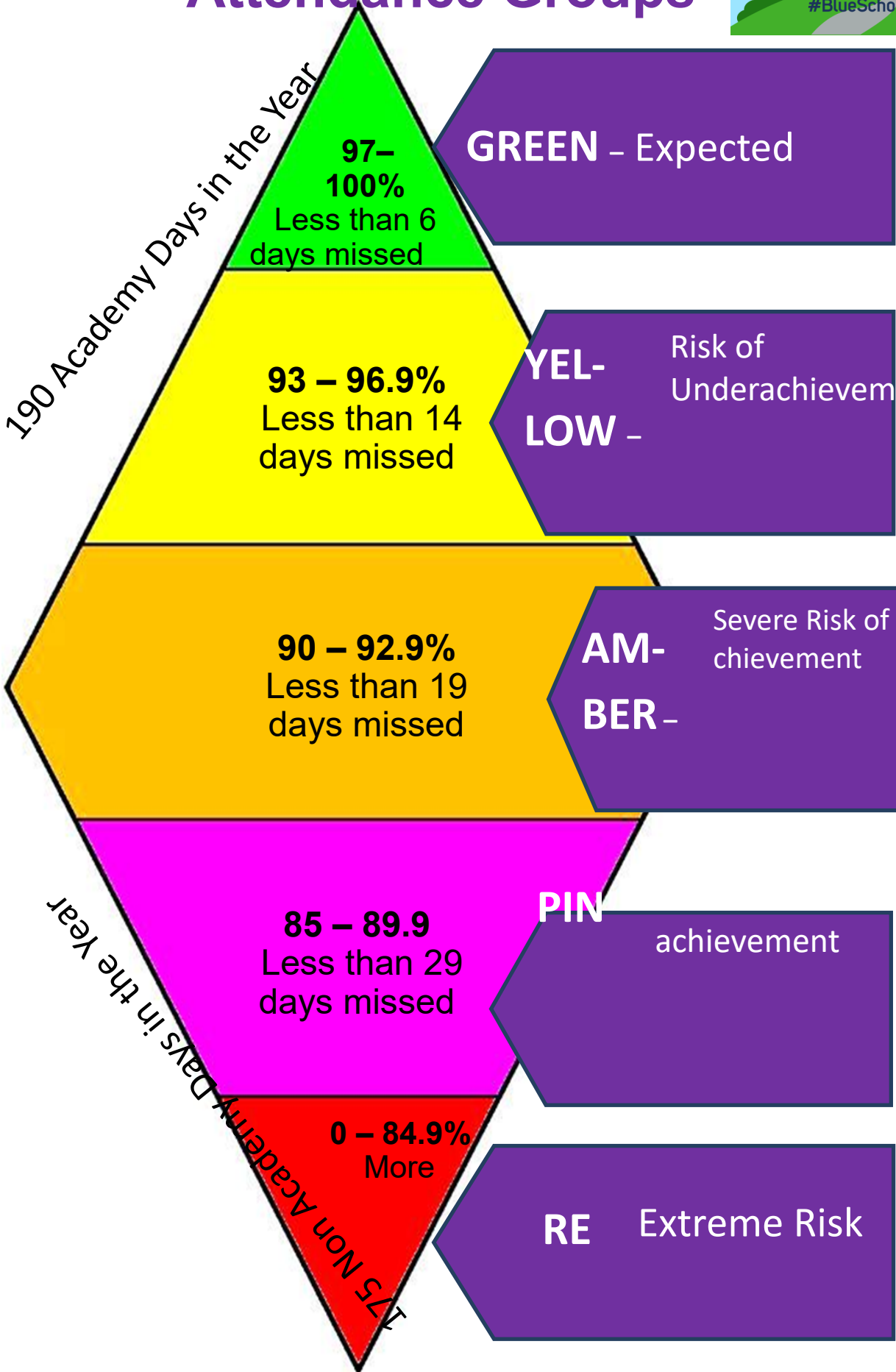
