SPOTLIGHT ON ENGLISH



Each week we want to let you know a bit more about the subjects we teach at OABL.

At Oasis Bank Leaze all children take part in daily English sessions:

- Writing-linked to class story.
- Reading- Children have the opportunity to learn the skills of reading this is linked to our thematic learning

(Geography, History and Art).

- Phonics- Children in EYFS and KS1 learn the skills of early learning through the use of the phonics fairy and Professor Lexicon.
- . Read aloud- 15 minutes at the end of each school day. A time for all children at Bank
- 1:1 Reading- All children at Bank Leaze have the opportunity for 1:1 reading and throughout the term will also read 1:1 with an adult.
