Our aim is that all of our pupils have a growth mindset towards Maths and recognise how it is important for them in their every-day lives and within our world. We are teaching them to be fluent in the core mathematical concepts and to use precise mathematical vocabulary as much as possible and applying these to real life situations. We use Number Blocks on the BBC website, Sumdog and TTRS to support our pupils with their fluency and understanding.
