We have all had a great week working together and achieving and completing the children's first national tests (these were our COVID children in Y2 so missed the tests as they were in 2020). As a school, we work hard across the 7 years children are with us to make sure they are ready to achieve at every stage of their education. Y6 certainly put that in to action this week. We will find out the results in July. Whatever the outcome, we are very proud of all of Y6.

TRANSITION TO THE NEXT CLASS

This offer will be enhanced for SEND children to meet their individual needs.
