Y6 SATs RESULTS

We are beyond thrilled to let you know that we have had our BEST EVER SATs results (again!) this year. **Our results are 18% above the national average putting us amongst some of the best schools in Bristol.** The school gets judged on how many children get the 'Expected Standard' in all the subjects (reading, writing and maths) combined. They also look at how many children we get achieving Greater Depth Standard in all subjects too-we think this is 11% above national average. The children have done amazingly well and we are SO proud of them. All of the children made expected with the majority making better than expected progress from KS1 at Bank Leaze we make every day count and it shows, if you send your child to us everyday we do all we can to get them to where they need to be! A huge well done to all involved in this. An increase on results for the past 5 years running is an amazing achievement.
