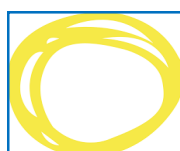

Kids Matter will be running for 6 weeks for parents and carers in your area soon!

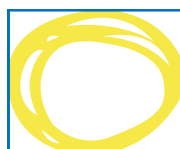
