Wednesday 12th November- Whole school trip to St Paters church for remembrance day leaving at 9:15am.

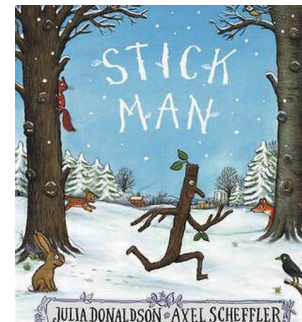
EYFS nativity performance 11th December at 2pm.
